# 2017 GIFT SHEEP COMPETITION

Entries received before 5.00pm Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2017 will be listed in the show catalogue. After your entry is received you will be sent instructions regarding collection/delivery of your sheep. The Area Co-ordinator will supply you with *Gift Sheep Competition Allflex* eartag. You must ensure you send an ASD (animal status declaration). Proceeds of all entries entered in the gift sheep class becomes the property of the Association.
