**Class 7001 Bread Loaf White or Wholemeal Loaf** Made in a bread maker or oven-baked

**Class 7008 Three Pieces Shortbread**

**Recipe:**

225g (8oz) Butter    125g (4oz) Icing Sugar

125g (4oz) Cornflour    225g (8oz) Flour

Cream butter and sugar well, add sifted flour and cornflour, knead well, roll out 12 to 18 mm ( $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch) thick. Cut into pieces. Place on greased tray, prick and bake about 30 minutes at 150°C (300°F)

**Class 7009 Three Pieces Uncooked Slice**

**Class 7010 Boiled Sultana Cake (Half)**

**Recipe:**

450g (1lb) Sultanas 350g (12 oz) Flour

225g (8 oz) Butter    1 teaspoon Baking Powder

225g (8 oz) Sugar    1 teaspoon Lemon Essence

3 Eggs

Cover sultanas with water, boil 15 minutes and drain.

Add butter and when melted, add sugar mixed with the eggs, then sift in flour and baking powder.

Mix in essence and bake in a 200 mm (8 inch) tin at 160°C (132°F) about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  hours.
